### **Presidents Letter**



#### **Camping**

We have a limited number of electric sites available for registration. The electric sites will be given out as registrations are made for the Round-Up. We also have many primitive sites available. Some primitive sites will have hitching rails and will be made available as registrations are made for the Round-Up. If you want a particular site please register as soon as possible. Campfires are welcome and you are able to bring your own firewood if you have a fire ring, please bring it.

#### **Trails**

The Prairie Creek Reservoir and Cardinal Greenways horse trails are considered moderate to easy trails. Both trail systems give riders around 10 miles of trails to enjoy. The trails provide some great views of nature, the reservoir, and opportunities to see the wildlife found in these habitats. These trails do include some water and road crossings and are great for all levels of riders to enjoy their horse.

#### **Event Rules**

- Horses must remain on designated trails.
- Quiet time is 11:00 pm
- All pets must be kept on a leash
- No pets in the food area
- Horses are not permitted on the asphalt trail of the Cardinal Greenway
- Racing/Running horses on the camping grounds or trails is not permitted
- Don't forget to have fun AND be kind

Your signature on the registration form confirms that you understand the stated rules.

The event committee has the right to dismiss participants at any time when found in noncompliance with the rules. Your cooperation means a great weekend for everyone.
